Here are some great ways <u>YOU</u> can help make Topanga Elementary the **BEST** possible experience for your child!!

Committees:

- **Join TEP!** (Topanga Enrichment Programs)
 - TEP is the sole fundraising body at TECS. TEP is comprised of parents with a child enrolled at TECS that have donated at least \$1 to TEP. All parents on TEP volunteer their time to assist in fundraising to provide the students with enrichment programs they otherwise would not get through LAUSD.

Leadership

- Leadership is the school's "PTA". Each year the stakeholders at TECS vote on the parent representatives to determine which parents will be on the leadership board. At the meetings the committees provide updates and all old/new business related to the school is discussed.
