- Surplus discussion
  - \$334,000 TEP surplus from past years
  - How much to leave for an emergency fund?
    - \$200k decided on to be conservative
  - How much to spend this year?
    - \$134k available, doesn't have to be spent this year
      - Must not be a recurring expense
      - o Could class size reduction (CSR) teacher be considered?
        - LAUSD paid 50% of salary for CSR teacher in 2018 we should look into this for next year

Money for classrooms - \$500 amazon gift card per classroom now
